Jewers Doors Limited is a privately owned, family company dedicated to the design, manufacture, supply and installation of industrial doors and gates for use in many different sectors including local government, railways, airlines, ship yards and the MOD.

We operate from 2,400 square meters of factory and office space in Bedfordshire. We employ over 50 people to design and manufacture door systems which incorporate the very latest concepts and technology.

We operate at an international level, with a significant proportion of our output going to overseas customers.

We strive to achieve and maintain high ethical and moral standards that underpin our activities today, and help to ensure our business remains successful and sustainable in the future. We acknowledge and accept, within this remit we have environmental responsibilities, so our environmental business objectives are established and reviewed on an annual basis, alongside all other strategic planning.

Our environmental management system has been developed by us and, is independently accredited to the ISO 14001:2005 Environmental Management standard and we aim for 14001:2016 by September 2018

Our overriding commitments include:

- The prevention of pollution to the environment
- To fulfill our responsibilities with regards environmental legislation and compliance obligations.
- The conservation of resources through efficient design of products and effective planning of projects.
